Classifications

Group 1 chemicals are **collected free of charge** under the program, these chemicals are currently registered ag and vet chemicals manufactured by companies supporting the Industry Waste Reduction Stewardship initiative.

Group 2 chemicals are those chemicals that are no longer registered, unknown, unlabelled, out of date, or mixed ag/vet chemicals. A per lt/kg fee applies for disposal unless a state government subsidy is in place.

Translating Services Available

There are only six steps to the program, it's that simple:

Step 1:

Inventory Required

Prior to calling the booking line take a list of the chemicals you are disposing of and include:

- manufacturers name
- product name
- container size
- number of containers
- estimation of remaining chemical in container
- container integrity



Step 2:

Register chemicals for collection @

Step 3:

Continue to store your registered chemicals safely and securely

Step 4:

ChemClear will contact you direct to advise the location of the collection point for retrieval and provide a quotation for any Group 2 chemicals registered for pick up

Step 5:

Prepare chemicals for delivery to collection site

Step 6:

Deliver your chemicals to the advised retrieval site.
