



# GROUP 1 AND 2 CHEMICAL CLASSIFICATIONS

## CLASSIFICATIONS

**Group 1** chemicals are **collected free of charge** under the program, these chemicals are currently registered ag and vet chemicals manufactured by companies supporting the Industry Waste Reduction Stewardship initiative.

**Group 2** chemicals are those chemicals that are no longer registered, unknown, unlabelled, out of date, or mixed agvet chemicals. A fee applies for disposal unless a state government subsidy is in place.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSIFICATIONS

**Group 1 Chemicals** are currently registered agvet chemicals manufactured by members of CropLife Australia Limited, Animal Health Alliance (Australia) Limited, the Veterinary Manufacturers and Distributors Association (VMDA) and other participating manufacturers of the Industry Waste Reduction Scheme (IWRS).

Recovery and disposal of Group 1 chemicals are funded by a portion of the existing **drumMUSTER** levy.

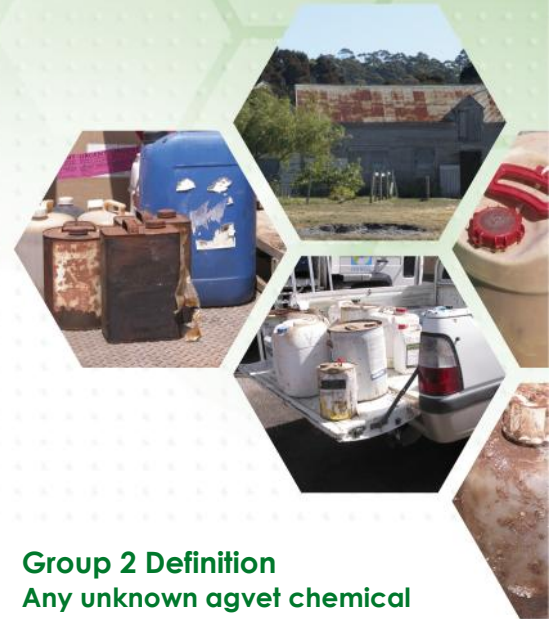
### Group 1 Eligibility

#### Collected FREE - The chemical must:

- be in its original container (**drumMUSTER** eligible)
- have a readable product label
- not have been mixed with any other product (incl water)
- be within two years of its expiry date, or, deregistration date

### Group 2 Definition

#### Any unknown agvet chemical including:

- chemicals without labels or any identifiable features
- mixed chemicals
- out of date or de-registered by over 2 years.

### Quotations

A per l/kg fee applies for disposal of Group 2 chemicals under the ChemClear program.

Waste holders registering Group 2 chemicals will be **provided with a quotation after their registration** is made and prior to the collection of their registered chemicals. The cost of individual chemicals will be dependent on the types of chemicals registered for disposal. The waste holder can accept or decline the quotation.
